Apart from saying 'hello', **don't talk** to the assessor. The assessor will just listen to you and takes no part in the interaction.

Always try to answer the interlocutor's questions by giving some extra information, clarification or reasons.

Don't just give one-word answers. This does not give a very good impression and you want to show the assessor what you can do right from the start!

Always listen to your partner's answers because the interlocutor may ask you both the same question. It's a good idea to disagree and have something different to say or to agree and to add to what your partner has said.

Remember to speak clearly and loudly enough so that both examiners can hear you.

Take a deep breath and relax before you go into the exam room. This will help you to feel more confident.
